



Age distribution (data from USFS Demographics chart).

We left out the 9 colts and 26 fillies listed as 1 year-old or less from the age distribution.

Over 1 year:

- 29.3 are below 10 years old
- 70.7 are above 10 years old

The population is aging. Either from previous roundups or predation (or other non-defined reason), it is important to analyze age distribution.

In the 1-year and under category, only 25% of the foals are male, 75% are female. This indicates the natural ratio of males to females is 1 to 4. If this is not the natural ratio it indicates that nature is trying to make up for some population growth deficit.

There are 112 mares and 130 studs in total, with the following counts by reported age group (including fractional ages and “20+” as their own groups).
